## Introduction;

(Homophile means FRIENDS of homosexuals to persons who can not say homosexual.) Can you imagine the necessary ego that had been rubbed raw that would make you form or join a homophile organization?

So it was in a context of a society of enemyies on one side and friends and lovers on the other side that I \*\*EXXXXX\*\* started to organize homosexuals into a revolution ary mode. Therefore you will not find the expected names, times, dates, places, etc. that go into the usual books of recrimination and CLORY littering our libraries and bookstores. Emotional, physical, mental means of dealing with life when you are a homosexual is all the contents. The ideas that work are what must be discussed.

When it comes to per PERSONNALITIES or LEADERS there is only one way to deal with them; have them make an appointment with a rigid time limit and if they show up without an appointment, slam the door in their face. (A leader or personnality is someone with a weak ego who can not accept themself.) While the events are facts; mames that do exist are changed or personnality.

When our work started their was what was called the homophile movement, some of that bullshit still exists. Later their evolved from New York a bag of wind movement called gay lib or the gay movement. These can only be discussed in the context of mistakes of perverted judgements. This is about homosexual revolution.

as I get into research for material for book the first interview, by accident, not design, is is with Guy Strait. He has served time for pornography dealing with minors involved in the porno as well as being the person to start League for Civic Education. He talks about Clark Pollack from philadelphia who started Janus Society and Drummer magazine as being the first person in the United States to open a pornography xx book store etc. and that he eventually sold out his stores to the Mafia. Guy started into an organization in San Francisco to oppose the Mattachine Society as run by Hal Call. Mattachine degenerated into a porno book store and porno movie joint.

By design I start interviewing Charles Morris who almost immediately gets into his big story about the mafia in the homosexual community and their connection with the control of pornography. That is why, he says, he was working for Roland Boudault -- to investigate him. Charles turns over a file to me of grand jury transcipts containing names of porno persons in

California as controlled by mafia.

There seems to be a direct link in many persons rationales about the homosexual movement and a connection with porno--WHY? Is there an intense frustration with sexual fulfillment that caused a great deal of the motivations for persons in the homosexual revolution? This brings into question my motivation for getting into the movement as a feeling -- a profound traumitizing outrage -- that their was great injustice connected with \* homosexuality in our society and in the treatment of homosexuals.

--OR--maybe that is why I succeeded in my organizational work while Guy went to jail after a rather debauched existence, Clark committed suicide after being taken for his wealth by young guys, Hal is a diseased old alcoholic running a sleazy porno place, Charlesix presently is ending his existence diseased and lonely with nothing to show for his many talents. two cat gories of persons, those like Charles and above who cultivate disease and those who fight disease to try to make themselves

## Introduction

Traditionally, our western civilization has been structured on the family unit of father-mother-children. When this family unit is upset, all hell breaks loose; we do not know how to handle the situation. If little Billy doesn't grow up to be big Bill, father with awife, children and a job to support them, everyone views the situation as tragic, a deterioration of morals, an attempt to destroy society, and, for the homosexual individual, a warped, incomplete life.

Social continuance is threatened by practicing homosexuals. Our conditioned thinking process and our societal structure is unable to deal with individuals who continue a lifestyle and sexuality that does not conform to what we have been taught is normal. Homosexuals become the black sheep in family circles who is not spoken about. Our social structure dictates controls be placed on those who deviate from the norm if we are to continue as a healthy, productive society.

The Kinsey report in the 1950s began to revolutionize our thinking processes. With the continued anthropological and sociological research, facts emerged that confirmed that irrespective of the society, a certain number of little girls and boys always grow up to be homosexual men and women. As more scientific studies are published on society, we find a significant and static number of persons in all

societies, at all times, who are homosexuals.

In America we find that homosexuals have been contributing, producing, and creating significantly giving added dimension and quality to the lives of all persons. Yet homosexuals hide their identity as homosexuals from society and from those around them. The reasons are all too obvious. The role assigned to homosexuals is that of scapegoat. Particularly assinine and evil in their pursuit and control of homosexuality are religious persons in our society. Christians have a great deal to atone for in their vicious, outrageous denegation and cruelty directed towards homosexuals. The handmaiden of their enforcement procedures, our police departments, have killed, beaten, brutalized, robbed, imprisoned, and subjected homosexuals to every manner of explotation with impunity. Blessed are the police for upholding the morals as well as the laws and the protection of societal standards.

In the 1960s some homosexuals began to say that enough is enough. Stop now. The facts showed homosexuals are no more immoral, nor destructive, nor unfulfilled than heterosexuals. In fact, amongst the homosexual population of this country ware found person's producing great and lasting contributions

upgrading the quality of all our lives.

San Francisco 1964, there was laid the basis for the homosexual revolution. New York 197\_, there was an incident that sparked a different thrust called gay liberation. These movements came into conflict at times, and worked together at times, beginning a process of change in United States societal standards that can never be reversed. That's what this book is all about, the beginnings of homosexuals struggling for Americans to face the facts of homosexual life. We call this the homosexualization of the cities.
