


J J Van Dyck



To further his ambition of a singing career, he is continuing singing lessons.







What is the Society for Individual Rights?

This is an organization dedicated to the fulfillment of human individual values regardless of sexual orientation. We believe these concerns can best be fulfilled by accomplishing responsible actions as responsible persons in responsible ways.


The following preamble to our constitution affirms our dedication.

Believing in our democratic heritage and that ethical values are self-determined and limited only by every person's right to decide his own, we organize under this constitution for:the reaffirming of individual pride and dignity regardless of orientation; the elimination of the public stigma attached to human self-expression; the accomplishing of effective changes in unjust laws concerning private relationships among consenting adults; the giving of real and substantial aid to members in difficulties; the promoting of better physical, mental, and emotional health; the creating of a sense of community; and the establishing of an attractive social atmosphere and constructive outlets for members and friends.

SIR was formed as an inclusive democratic organization. The ruling body is a Board of Directors which is directly responsible to the membership. All members of the Board have specific areas of authority and responsibility so that all Directors are working heads of projects and standing committees. The Board has four general directors President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer; and eight specific chairmen: Community Services, Legal, Membership, Political, Publications, Religious, Social, Vector. To keep a check on financing and directives that would require membership adherence, a Ways and Means Committee has been set up which must investigate finances, inventories, membership regulations, and make recommendations before final actions may be taken.

Our dedication to these principles is based on a belief that the average person can aid the achievement of these ends, therefore SIR's membership is designed to include all persons who will ascribe to the principles which recognize the individual's right to pursue his own fulfillment as long as he does not encroach on the similar right of others. Many have found the need to replace the self-effacing standards of unacceptance that have been drilled into them. For some of us a worthwhile, open, unharrassed life as a self-respecting individual has started to be realized by our working together with dignity and pride. Towards this end we wish to expand the sound basis already started in SIR that is creating a responsible social fabric. Everyone who feels a similar need is urged to investigate our organization further. We welcome you.


