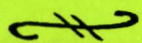

San Francisco Arcadds Theatre is a group of people dedicated to showing the world a personal part of the AIDS/ARC epidemic using live theatre as the means of communication.

People have a funny relationship with theatre: they can't just "take it or leave it." They have to get involved; they have to react to it; they have to discuss it; they have to think about it.

The actors of San Francisco Arcadds Theatre (SFAAT), all of whom have been diagnosed with ARC or AIDS, have unique relationships with the pieces they perform. All the pieces have been written by members of the troupe. The Theatre does its own writing, producing, directing, choreography, music, costumes, sets and set design. Not bad for a bunch of would-be's? Not bad at all!

The members of SFAAT are dedicated to professionalism. Hours are spent on writing and rehearsing. After all, the lives of the performers are on the line...not just their careers! Each performer is dedicated to doing the best possible, health permitting.

THE MESSAGE

The performing members of SFAAT are out to let the world know that somebody 'out there' would like to help somebody else 'out there'

learn a little more about this horrific epidemic...that somebody out there is willing to publicly put his or her life on the line on the stage just to get a point across...that somebody out there is putting out a hand for somebody else to hold and get strength from.

We have discovered that, for us, theatre is the best means of reconciling a vast need to communicate with a waning energy resource. The magic of theatre allows us to take our most intense emotions and channel them into a broadcasting beam on which you can walk and experience with us. This union-and-exchange transcends the barriers of usual conversation and communication.

THE PERFORMERS

All of the performing members of San Francisco Arcadds Theatre have been diagnosed with ARC or AIDS and are committed and dedicated to assuring the viewing public of a quality performance and an entertaining experience while the audience learn about the AIDS epidemic from our own personal vantage point...from the front line...from our most intimate thoughts.

REPEIOIRE

San Francisco Arcadds Theatre presently has approximately 30 original pieces which either

have been performed or are slated to be performed in the near future. These pieces run the gamut. They range in length from 2½ to 15 minutes each. They require from one to six characters. They are comedic, dramatic, musical...all of which have a deliberate poignance. Each piece is a direct route from our minds and hearts to yours.

To date, SFAAT's performances have been to 'invitation only' audiences, with the exception of our performance at the 1988 10th Annual Gay Musical Celebration. Our performances have been to AIDS/ARC organizations, hospitals, and AIDS/ARC local conferences.
