D'Anne takes the inside track in bid for supe seat

It's great when a candidate for public office says they're going to solve virtually all of the city's problems of housing and homelessness, traffic and parking, and access to health care. ...

But which off the candidates has the experience in the bowels of the bureaucracy, where things either get done or they don't — regardless of how much money is thrown at the problem?

"Many candidates are claiming they are going to solve these prob-

lems," said District 6 candidate Denise D'Anne, "while I've been in there working on these things for years. These are not new issues." ...

"Basically, it is all common sense," said D'Anne, who has a strong passion for teaching people to practice efficiency and economy in daily living. "And they don't understand that in our society because they're used to wasting things. ...

D'Anne, a self-described transgender person who sits on the executive board of the Harvey Milk Lesbian,

Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Democratic Club, has strong backing from labor, recently winning an endorsement from the San Francisco Labor Council, which represents 150 union locals with 80,000 workers, in addition to the Service Employees International Union and the Firefighters Union locals.

In 1998, when D'Anne ran for supervisor citywide, she received 34,000 votes In that race she had the backing of the San Francisco Tenant's Union ...

As Supervisor, Denise will continue her work for the Queer Community. Denise is a member of Pride At Work/AFL-CIO, the organization for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender labor, representing that group as a delegate to the San Francisco Labor Council. As a union member she helped write by-laws that forbade discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation.
