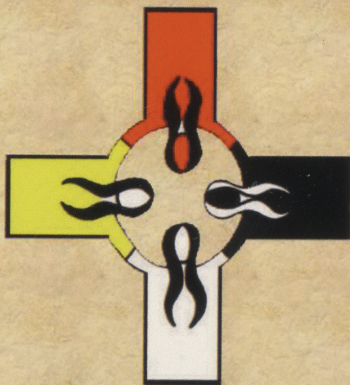


# Shake The Feathers

## Ways we are reducing the risk of HIV for ourselves and our partners

### Partner Choice Strategies

- ✧ *avoiding places/people that cause risky behavior*
- ✧ *choosing partners based on their HIV status*
- ✧ *finding people you can talk to/social groups*
- ✧ *eliminating casual partners*
- ✧ *reducing the number of casual partners*

### Condom/Barrier Usage

- ✧ *always carrying condoms/barriers*
- ✧ *increasing the use of condoms/barriers*

### Disclosure/Communication Strategies

- ✧ *telling my partners that I have HIV*
- ✧ *asking my partners if they have HIV*
- ✧ *talking to my partners about safer sex*

### Drug-related Strategies

- ✧ *using a needle exchange program*
- ✧ *cleaning drug works with bleach*
- ✧ *not sharing needles/works*
- ✧ *not having sex while using alcohol/drugs*
